

Student Regulations

The Student Regulations contain what we expect from students and what students can expect from the school. A part of this is covered by rules, but it is also covered in a more general way. For this, we use a number of values that we feel are important for everyone in Greijdanus.



It begins with Following Christ. We wish to live with the God of the Bible. Christ shows how God loves us and that we may live in faith through grace. By following Christ, we show our love for other people.



Then comes 'Growth'. We are at school to learn. For a diploma, to get to know Christ and on the way to adulthood. Then you're ready to take your place in society. Students actively commit themselves to this. The school offers an environment that helps you to develop.
